Dear Mr. Schroth,

On December 12, 2020, the South Dakota Department of Agriculture (SDDA) was notified of an alleged incident related to a pesticide application. The SDDA completed an investigation and determined that pesticide applications were made in violation of label requirements. Such violations are a Class 2 misdemeanor subject to civil penalties of up to \$5,000 per offense and/or suspension or revocation of a license.

Prior to pursuing a civil action in circuit court, the SDDA offers to settle this matter with you in the amount of \$3,444. Enclosed with this letter is a Settlement and Release Agreement. If you are willing to settle in this manner, please sign and return the agreement to the SDDA with a check made out to the SDDA. Upon receipt of payment and signed agreement, a receipt and a copy of the fully executed agreement will be returned.

This offer of a settlement will remain valid until May 7, 2021. Absent a response by May 7th, or if the settlement offer is rejected, the SDDA will commence formal legal action in circuit court.
